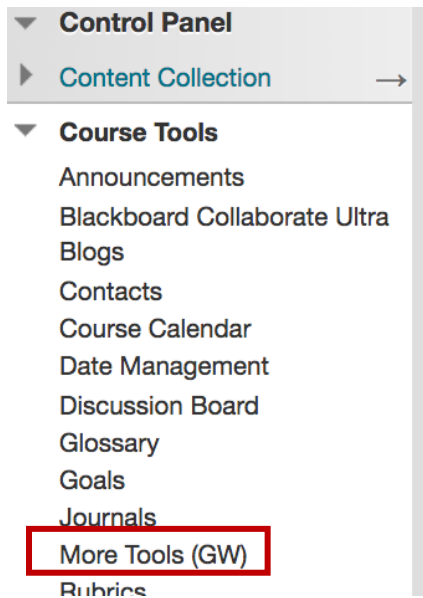


Create a Development Course in Blackboard

Get a head start on the semester with Development Courses in Blackboard.

Use a Development Course to experiment with Blackboard or to develop a new course before your official course is created for the semester. When you are ready to use it to teach a specific term and section of a class, you can [copy your development course](#) into the official course.



1. Open a Blackboard course in which you are the instructor.
2. Go to the **Control Panel** and select **Course Tools**.
3. Click **More Tools (GW)**.

4. On the resulting page, click **Create Development Course**.
