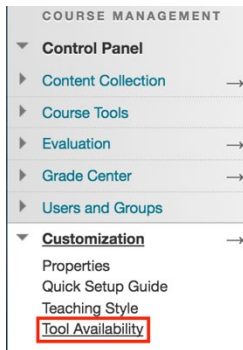


Enable Blackboard Collaborate Ultra

Blackboard Collaborate Ultra is a newer alternative to the Collaborate Original Experience. Collaborate with the Ultra experience is entirely web-based and sessions open right in your browser. Additionally, you do not need to install Java or download files to participate in a session. The following explains how to enable Collaborate Ultra in a Blackboard Course.

1. In your Blackboard course, go to the **Control Panel**, click **Customization** and select **Tool Availability**.



2. On the *Tool Availability* page, uncheck all boxes next to *Blackboard Collaborate* and check the box next to **Blackboard Collaborate Ultra**.

3. Click **Submit**. You and your students can now access Blackboard Collaborate Ultra from the *Tools* area on the Course Menu.

1. Click the **+** at the top left corner of your *Course Menu*.
2. Choose **Tool Link**.
3. In the drop-down menu, choose **Blackboard Collaborate Ultra**.
4. Enter a **Name** in the text box and check the box next to **Available to Users**.
5. Click **Submit**.
